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- 1 You are the person undertaking the works, for example the demolition contractor. If this is a company, please give the address of the head office.
- 2 No Notice need be given under Section 80 of the Building Act 1984 for the following works:
 - (a) a demolition in pursuance of a demolition order made under the Housing Act 1957, and
 - (b) a demolition -
 - (i) of an internal part of a building, where the building is occupied, and it is intended that it should continue to be occupied,
 - (ii) of a building that has a cubic content (as ascertained by external measurement) of not more than 1750 cu feet (50m³), or, where a greenhouse, conservatory, shed or prefabricated garage forms part of a larger building.
 - (iii) without prejudice to sub-paragraph (ii) above, of an agricultural building (as defined in section 26 of the General Rate Act 1967), unless it is contiguous to another building that is not itself an agricultural building or a building of a kind mentioned in that sub-paragraph.
- 3 Section 80(4) of the Building Act 1984 refers to the powers of the local authority in respect of failure to provide the required notice. On summary conviction a fine may be applicable.

- 4 Notification should be given to the Health and Safety Executive if the building is thought to contain asbestos.
- One copy of this notice should be completed and submitted together with a block plan and a site location plan, of the building to be demolished and copies of the method statement and asbestos survey where available.
- No demolition work must commence before this notice is given to the local authority and either (i) the local authority has given notice under section 81 of the act or(ii) six weeks has lapsed from the serving of this notice.
- 7 These notes are for general guidance only; particulars regarding the submission of Demolition Notices are contained in section 80 of the Building Act 1984.
- Persons proposing to carry out building work or make a material change of use of a building are reminded that permission may be required under the Town and Country Planning Acts and Building Regulations.
- 9 Further information and advice concerning the Building Regulations and Planning matters may be obtained from relevant departments at Carlisle City Council.
- 10 If you intend to demolish a building you are also advised to contact Development Management at Carlisle City Council on 01228 817179 to ascertain in permission is required under the Town and County Planning Acts.
