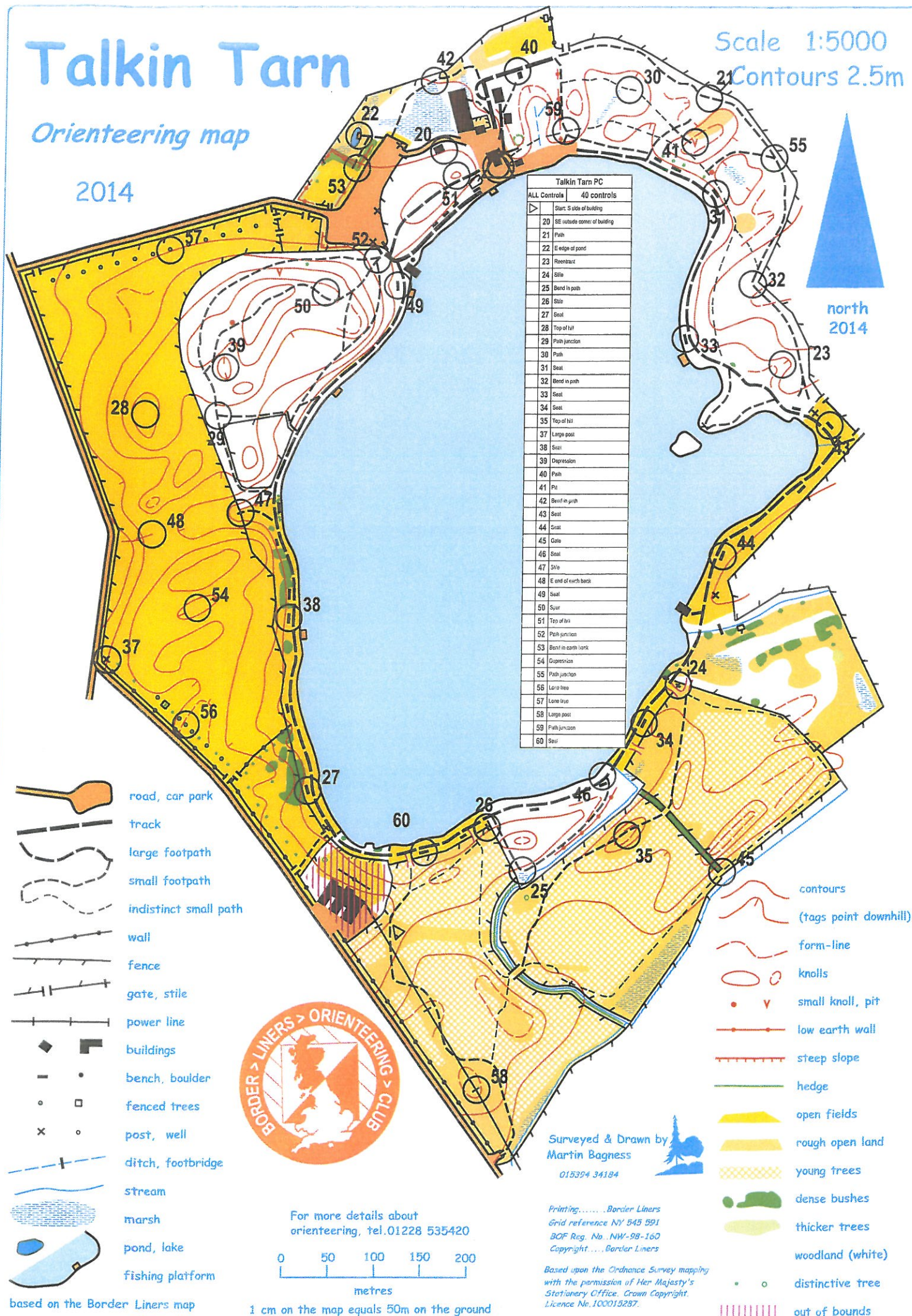

Talkin Tarn Permanent Orienteering Course

Permanent Course Pack;

- You will need a Pencil or Biro to record the two letter codes as you navigate round each course

This Pack contains;

- **Two Orienteering Maps** at a scales of 1:3000 and 1:5000, showing the position of controls (checkpoints). The 1:3000 map is a small section of the Tarn and is recommended for those of you who are new to the sport of Orienteering. The map shows open ground in yellow and trees in white. All symbols are on the legend (key) on the map.
- **Four blank Control Cards.** For you to record your progress as you visit the controls on the course you have chosen to have a go at.
- **A Control Description Sheet**, which tells you all about the controls on the course. Take this with you.
