

### Council Buildings: Access Details

#### Community Centres

1. **Belah** Briar Bank (Tel: 01228 **625325**)  
Car park in front of building. Ramped access. Accessible WC. Steps down into small hall. Induction loop in main hall.
2. **Botcherby** Victoria Road. (Tel: 01228 **625320**)  
On street parking but small parking area in grounds by arrangement. 2 ramped entrances (one to new extension at the rear). Automatically opening door to main entrance. Meeting rooms and large hall. Induction loop. Narrow access to kitchen facilities. 2 accessible WCs.
3. **Currock (Currock House)** Lediard Avenue (Tel: 01228 **625350**)  
On street parking. Level access to the main hall and facilities in the extension at the rear, approached from the side of the old building. Induction loop in main hall. Unisex accessible WC in rear extension. External ramp to gym, accessible showers and changing rooms with unisex accessible WC. Steps to the front of the old listed building. No lift access to first floor meeting rooms. However, ground floor meeting room has wheelchair access from the back of the building and also an accessible WC by the rear entrance door.
4. **Greystone** Close Street. (Tel: 01228 **818556**)  
On street parking but also small parking area in front of ramped main entrance by arrangement. Automatically opening doors. Large hall with induction loop. Smaller meeting rooms. Kitchen facilities. Separate male and female wheelchair accessible WCs.
5. **Denton Holme** Morley Street. (Tel: 01228 **520838**)  
On street parking (cobble street with high kerbs). Ramped entrance. Large hall and meeting rooms. Induction loop. Narrow access to kitchen facilities for wheelchair users. Accessible WC off entrance hall.
6. **Harraby** Edgehill Road (Tel: 01228 **527313**)  
Parking near to entrance of main hall. Ramp for internal steps to main hall. Accessible shower and changing facilities. Small meeting rooms. 2 accessible WCs.
7. **Longtown** Carlisle Road, Longtown (Tel: 01228 **791876**)  
Parking nearby. Level access but with high threshold. Meeting room and large hall. Induction loop. Unisex accessible WC. Lift access to first floor bar. Showers and sauna not yet wheelchair accessible.

8. **Morton (Morton Manor)**, Wigton Road (Tel: 01228 **528309**)  
Large car park with designated spaces for disabled people. Small ramp to entrance. Variety of meeting rooms. Induction loop available in two rooms. Lift access to all floors. Internal ramp in gym area. Kitchen and bar facilities. Two accessible WCs (1 by Reception to Part M standard)
9. **Raffles Community House**, Raffles Avenue (Tel: 01228 **515948**)  
Small car park in front of the building. Accessible front entrance although wall heater restricts turning space. Unisex wheelchair accessible WC. No wheelchair access to first floor facilities.
10. **Irthing Centre**, Union Lane, Brampton (Tel: 016977 **45023**)  
Two car parks for different parts of the large building which was formerly a school. Accessible entrances. Induction loops. Chairlift down to main hall. Wheelchair accessible WCs and shower facilities. Chairlift to Business Centre.
11. **Yewdale**, Hutton Way (Tel: 01228 **591270**)  
Public car park near entrance. Level access. Meeting room. Unisex wheelchair accessible WC. Induction loop in main hall. Accessible nursery in attached portacabin.

## **Leisure and Recreation**

12. **Bitts Park Pavilion** (Tel: 01228 **625545**)  
Accessible low level serving hatch for refreshments. Accessible WC and changing facilities in the pavilion. Level access to all weather tennis courts.
13. **Talkin Tarn Country Park**, Brampton (Tel: **016977 3129**)  
4 designated parking bays near to the tea room. New internal lift access to 1st floor tea room (and also new external ramp) New external WC block with unisex wheelchair accessible WC. New timber classroom building with 2 wheelchair accessible WCs (left and right hand orientated). Induction loop in classroom.
14. **City Baths (The Pools)** James Street (Tel: 01228 **625777**)  
Parking for disabled people at the rear. Accessible rear entrance. Automatically opening front entrance doors (James Street). Lower section and induction loop at reception counter. Lift serves each floor. Family sized changing rooms. Accessible WCs on entrance and lower ground floor levels. Portable hoist available for entry into the water. Café area has coin operated machines for drinks and food. Wheelchair access to top of viewing gallery.
15. **Currock Bowling Green Pavilion**, Scalegate Road  
Wheelchair accessible building with accessible WC
16. **Millennium Gallery (Tullie House)** Castle Way (Tel: 01228 **534781**)  
Entrance via Tullie House. Automatically opening entrance doors. Lift access down to gallery. All parts of the gallery are wheelchair accessible. Wheelchair accessible WC.

17. **The Sands Centre** (Tel: 01228 **625222**)  
 Large car park with designated spaces near to the entrance. Level entrance and automatically opening doors. Lower section to reception counter. Lift access to first floor. Unisex accessible WCs on both floors. Wheelchair accessible shower/WC facility. Induction loop in part of main concert hall. Accessible café and bars No lower section to the bar. Gym facilities for wheelchair users.
18. **Sheepmount** (Tel: 01228 **625599**)  
 This is a new, fully accessible building. There is ramped access from the parking area to the front entrance and a ramp down to the athletics track. All the changing facilities and public areas are accessible.
19. **St James' Park Pavilion**, Norfolk Road (Tel: 01228 **625540**)  
 This building is not wheelchair accessible.
20. **Stony Holme Golf Club**, St Aidans Road (Tel: 01228 **625511** (golf) or **625512** (restaurant/bar)  
 Level access internally to restaurant and bar. Unisex accessible WC.
21. **Swifts Driving Range**, Swifts Bank Car Park (Tel: 01228 **625530**)  
 Reserved car parking in Swifts Bank Car Park. Access via long ramp. Accessible shop and accessible WC.
22. **Tullie House Museum and Art Gallery** Castle Way (Tel: 01228 **534781**)  
 This is a Grade 1 listed building with a large modern extension. The galleries in the extension are fully accessible with lift access to the upper floor and a unisex accessible WC on each floor. There are ramped approaches to main entrance and also the rear entrance on Castle Street with automatically opening doors to both. On the ground floor there is a shop and restaurant/bar with table service available on request. The ground floor of Old Tullie House is accessible with small ramped thresholds between rooms. The first floor is not wheelchair accessible but there is a platform stair lift to the lower ground floor leading to the Education Rooms and the front of the raked Lecture Theatre which has an induction loop and wheelchair spaces. Illustrated albums of the first floor exhibits are provided for those who are not able to gain access. There is wheelchair access and spaces to the rear of the Lecture theatre.
23. **Upperby Park Cafe (Hammonds Pond)** (Tel: 01228 **817362**)  
 Open in the summer only. Wheelchair accessible approach and entrance. Accessible WC.

## Others

24. **Anchorage Pensioners' Centre**, St Cuthbert's Lane  
 This small building is wheelchair accessible and has café facilities with table service and accessible WC.
25. **Burial Chapel**, Carlisle Cemetery, Richardson Street  
 (Tel; 01228 **625310**)  
 Fully accessible with accessible WC and induction loop.

26. **Stanwix Burial Chapel**, Scotland Road, Stanwix (Tel: 01228 **625310**)  
Ramped entrance. Induction loop.
27. **Civic Centre**, Rickergate (Tel: 01228 **817000**)  
2 designated parking spaces at the front and also in public car park to the side. Ramped and stepped entrance. Automatically opening entrance doors. Unisex Wheelchair WC on ground floor and also separate baby changing cubicle. 3 refurbished lifts to upper floors (not Part M dimensions) with clear visual, tactile and voice indicators. Induction loops at Reception and Customer Contact desks. Induction loops in Council Chamber and main meeting rooms. Wheelchair space available for public in Council Chamber but no wheelchair access to public gallery. Accessible WC adjacent to Council Chamber entrance on 1st floor.
28. **Crematorium**, Dalston Road (Tel: 01228 **625310**)  
Designated parking places. All public areas of the building are wheelchair accessible with an accessible WC. Induction loop in chapel.
29. **Enterprise Centre Workshops**, James Street (Tel: 01228 **625700**)  
Parking to rear. Accessible ground floor Reception. Lift (large and old) access to first floor workshops and facilities. Separate male and female accessible WCs.
30. **Guildhall**, Greenmarket, City Centre (Tel: 01228 **625400**)  
This small medieval listed building is not wheelchair accessible. Entrance is via a steep wooden staircase. Floors uneven. Proposed video of exhibits to be available at Tullie House.
31. **Old Town Hall, (Tourist Information Centre)** English Street (Tel: 01228 **625600**)  
This is an old listed building with a steep, curved stepped entrance but with handrails both sides. There is an internal lift from the pavement area to the side of the entrance. There is a large meeting room with an induction loop and kitchen facilities. The accessible WC is not quite Part M layout due to restricted space.
32. **Shopmobility Centre** 2nd floor, The Lanes Car Park (Tel: 01228 **625950**)  
Lift access via Lanes Shopping Centre. Premises are fully accessible. Induction loop at reception desk.
33. **Bousteads Grassing (Carlisle Works)**, Rome Street (Tel: 01228 **625000**)  
Main entrance is wheelchair accessible and has automatically opening doors. There is a lobby door security entry system. Accessible meeting room and very spacious accessible WC. No wheelchair access to the first floor.
