THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (FOOTPATH NOS. 109084 AND 109097 IN THE CITY OF CARLISLE) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS) ORDER 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable Volkerstevin to carry out repair works to the footpaths following the flood defence work ("the Works"), the County Council of Cumbria intends to make an Order the effect of which is to prohibit pedestrians from proceeding along the following lengths of Footpath in the City of Carlisle:

1. An approx. 66 metre section of Public Footpath No. 109084 at Bitts Park in the City of Carlisle from Grid reference 339815 556259 to 339849 556315; and
2. An approx. 67metre section of Public Footpath No. 109097 at Bitts Park in the City of Carlisle from Grid reference 340259 556518 to 340290 556459.

There is no suitable alternative route available for pedestrians.

The Order will come into operation on 20 September 2021 and may continue in force for a period of up to six months from that date as and when the appropriate traffic signs are displayed, although it is anticipated that it will only be required for **8 weeks**.

THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (FOOTPATH NOS. 109084 AND 109097 IN THE CITY OF CARLISLE) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS) ORDER 2021

WHEREAS the County Council of Cumbria (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") being the traffic authority for Footpath Nos. 109084 and 109097 in the City of Carlisle is satisfied that pedestrian traffic in the said road should be restricted by reason of works being proposed to be executed thereon ("the Works").

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of their powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf hereby make the following Order.

1. No person shall proceed along the following lengths of Footpath in the City of Carlisle:
 - (i) An approx. 66 metre section of Public Footpath No. 109084 at Bitts Park in the City of Carlisle from Grid reference 339815 556259 to 339849 556315; and
 - (ii) An approx. 67metre section of Public Footpath No. 109097 at Bitts Park in the City of Carlisle from Grid reference 340259 556518 to 340290 556459.
2. Nothing in this Order shall apply other than at such times and to such extent as is indicated by the appropriate traffic signs.
3. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
4. This Order shall come into operation on the twentieth day of September 2021 and may be cited as The County of Cumbria (Footpath Nos. 109084 and 109097 in the City of Carlisle) (Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrians) Order 2021.
