## Arts, Culture & Heritage

#### Austin and Hope Pilkington Trust Opens for Round I Applications

Funding to support UK charities working with those who face the greatest challenges in society.

The deadline to apply for this round is 28 February 2022.

### Funding For Conservation and Digitisation of Jewish Archive and Library Collections

Charitable and not-for-profit organisations can apply for funding to protect, preserve, and enable better access to Jewish archival and library collections in Europe.

The application deadline for archives and libraries grants is 25 April 2022.

#### Development Funding for UK Food and Farming Social Enterprises

A blend of loan finance and grant funding is available to cooperatives, social enterprises and community businesses working in the UK's agriculture and food production sector to support and develop their work, helping to increase their social impact.

Applications may be made at any time.



## Communities - Urban & Rural Development

#### Funding for Community Facilities and Environmental Improvements in Communities Near Veolia Sites in England

The first round of funding for 2022 is now open for capital projects that improve community facilities, enhance the local environment, and protect threatened habitats and biodiversity in communities near qualifying Veolia sites.

The deadline for applications is 24 March 2022 (12noon).

#### Joseph Rowntree Charitable Trust Announces New £1m Pilot Fund

Following a 10-month consultation, the Joseph Rowntree Charitable Trust has released the first details of a new pilot fund aimed at grassroots movements seeking to create lasting change and transform intersecting structural inequalities within society.

The fund is expected to launch in 2022, with the potential for another two rounds after initial evaluation.

#### Launch of £27m Waking Watch Replacement Fund for England's Residential Dwellings

The Government has earmarked additional funds for the installation of alarms to replace costly Waking Watch measures for leaseholders in residential buildings in England.

Applications must be submitted by the deadline of Monday 28 March 2022 (11.59pm).





### **Children & Young People**

#### Blagrave Charitable Trust Announces Grants to Support Youth Involvement in Policy-Making

Charitable and not-for-profit organisations supporting young people (aged 16 to 25) facing disadvantage across England can now apply for their share of a £350,000 funding pot aimed at policy work.

The deadline to apply is 25 February 2022.



### **Digital & Technology**

#### Funding to Support Tech Lending Hubs in Temporary Accommodation Services Across UK

Hubbub and Virgin Media O2 have launched a new campaign to provide tablets and free data to community organisations working with temporary accommodation services to tackle digital exclusion and reduce e-waste.

The deadline for applications is I March 2022.





#### Energy, Environment and Climate

#### Industrial Energy Transformation Fund Phase 2: Spring 2022 Window Now Open

Businesses operating in some of the most polluting and energy-intensive industries can now bid for a share of government investment to help cut their carbon emissions and the costs of their energy bills.

The Phase 2 Spring 2022 competition window is now open. The deadline for applications is Friday 29 April 2022 (3pm).

#### Garfield Weston Foundation Provides Additional Support for Climate and Environmental Organisations

UK charities can apply to receive expert-led training, networking opportunities and one-toone sessions with media professionals to improve their climate communication.

The deadline to apply for the Communicating Climate Programme is 5pm on 15 February 2022.

#### Landscape Recovery Scheme Now Open to Applications

Land managers and farmers in England can apply for funding for wildlife and river projects.

Applications for the first round are open until 24 May 2022 (11.59pm).
