Funding for England's Businesses Taking on New Apprentices

Financial support is being provided to help employers in England hire new apprentices in a move designed to boost employment following the coronavirus outbreak.

The deadline for businesses to apply for these apprentices is Tuesday 30 November 2021.

Funding for Employers Supporting T Level Placements in England

Employers across England can access funding for T Level students they host on industry placements, as part of a new incentive scheme. Employers will be able to claim for up to 20 students for the available T Level subject areas until July 2022.

<u>Further COVID-19 Relief Funding for England's Airports</u>

Funding is available to ease pressure on commercial airports and ground handlers in England hit by the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. The next deadline for applications is Sunday 20 June 2021.

<u>Launch of TikTok #BeYourOwnBoss</u> <u>Entrepreneurship Competition</u>

A competition supporting young people in the UK with ambitious ideas to run their own business has been launched. The closing date for receipt of all entries is Wednesday 30 June 2021 (23:59 BST).

UK Businesses Encouraged to Join Flexible Plastic Fund Initiative

Funding and support are available to UK businesses to incentivise their recycling of 'flexible' plastic items including bags, wrappers, films, pouches, packets and sachets. Support may be accessed at any time.

The SME Brexit Support Fund

The SME Brexit Support Fund could give you up to £2,000 to help with training or professional advice, if your business has up to 500 employees and no more than £100 million annual turnover. Applications will close on Wednesday 30 June 2021 or earlier if all funding is allocated before this date.

<u>Asda Foundation - Bringing Communities</u> Back Together

Grants are available to local groups to reunite communities, celebrate togetherness and support groups as coronavirus restrictions are easing. The closing date for Phase 1 applications to be submitted to the Community Champion is 16 August 2021. However, if funds are depleted before the closing date, the fund will close early. Applicants are advised to check the website to confirm closing dates.

Poundland Announces New Foundation is Open for Applications

Poundland, the discount store chain, has set up a new charitable foundation which will make £ 825,000 available in cash grants over the next year. Money for the foundation will come from in-store fundraising, carrier bag donations and the partnership with Pennies, the charity that collects micro-donations through chip and pin machines. Although no deadline has been specified, there are only 250 grants. Groups should therefore apply as soon as possible.

Tampon Tax Fund Opens for Final Funding Round

The Government has announced charities across the UK can apply now for projects that improve the lives of vulnerable and disadvantaged women and girls in the UK.

The deadline for applications is midnight on Sunday 4 July 2021.

Virgin Media O2 Invites UK's Local Charities to Apply for Grants of £1,000

Local charities have until 14 June to apply for one of 500 grants to support environmental and community belonging projects that will inspire people across the UK to get together and create positive change as the nation emerges from the pandemic.
