## Arts Council England's National Lottery Project Grants Programme Reopens with New Guidelines

Individual artists, community and cultural organisations can now apply to the National Lottery Project Grants programme under its refreshed guidance.

Applications can be made at any time.

## Culture Recovery Fund: Emergency Resource Support - Round 2 Opens for England's Cultural Organisations

The Culture Recovery Fund: Emergency Resource Support programme has been established to provide emergency funding for culturally significant organisations in England. Those which were financially sustainable before coronavirus (COVID-19) but are now at imminent risk of failure, having exhausted all other options for increasing their resilience, are being supported.

This is a rolling programme and applications can be submitted between 29 November 2021 and 28 January 2022 (12pm) with decisions communicated within six weeks, where possible.







## Community Businesses in England Can Apply Now to the New Powering Up Programme

Funding for community businesses who are currently seeking support for digital skills that could help their business develop and grow.

The application window for the first round runs from 10 November to 13 December 2021.

### Driving the Electric Revolution - Launch of IUK's PEMD Skills Hub Competition

UK registered businesses and research organisations can apply for funding for the development of a Power Electronics, Machines and Drives (PEMD) skills hub in the UK.

The deadline for applications is **Wednesday 15 December 2021 (11am)**.

# Advance Notice of National Lottery Fund Platinum Jubilee Funding Programme.

To mark Her Majesty the Queen's 70th (Platinum) Jubilee, The National Lottery Community Fund will make funding available to 70 projects across the UK.

Opens to applications on Wednesday 17 November 2021 and closes at 5pm on Wednesday 15 December, unless 700 applications are received sooner.

### Applications Open for Grants to Mark Her Majesty the Queen's Platinum Jubilee

Non-profit organisations across the United Kingdom can now apply for their share of a £3.5 million pot from the National Lottery Community Fund, in celebration of Her Majesty the Queen's 70th year of reign.

The deadline for applications is 15 December 2021 (5pm) or once 700 applications are received, whichever comes first.

### Social Enterprise Support Fund to Open for New Round of Applications

Social enterprises in England will soon be able to apply for grants to fund activities which support communities affected by COVID-19, and to help organisations overcome any acute financial difficulties they are facing as a result of the pandemic

Round one opens at 1pm on 25 November 2021 and closes at 1pm on 21 December 2021.
