Forestry Commission Set to Launch England Woodland Creation Offer

A major new multi-million pound tree planting grant will soon be available, providing greater financial incentives for England's landowners and farmers to plant and manage trees.

Launch of £50m Scheme to Restore England's Peatlands

A competitive capital grant scheme is open to environmental groups, local authorities, charities, public bodies and landowners undertaking peat restoration projects in England.

Health & Social Welfare

Funding for UK Charities Working in the Field of Breast Cancer

Grants are available to breast cancer charities in the UK that assist people affected by breast cancer and organisations that work on breast cancer research and prevention. UK registered charities working in the field of breast cancer within the UK have until the end of May 2021 to submit their application to this annual fund.

Wolfson Foundation Bursaries for Hospice Staff

Bursaries available to hospice staff in the UK to improve the quality of care given to the patients in need of hospice and palliative care. Bursaries can be used to cover fees for university accredited palliative care courses including degree, masters and PhD level programmes and modules from the same. Some palliative care conferences may also be included.

Funding for Urban Tree Planting in England to Benefit Health and Wellbeing

Funding is available for planting thousands of trees in urban areas to help support people's health and wellbeing as well as wider environmental benefits.

New Funding to Support Armed Forces in Acute Hospital Settings

Grants are available for hospitals in the UK for projects that would focus on improving support to veterans who are receiving treatment as an inpatient within their hospital.

Safer Streets Fund

The Home Office (HO) is launching the third round of the Safer Streets Fund 2021/22 on 24 May. This round will focus on improving the safety of public places, with a particular focus on areas of potential concern to women and girls.





Sports & Recreation

<u>Sport England - Toyota Parasport Fund - End of May Deadline</u>

Funding for clubs and organisations in England that help disabled adults and young people aged five years and older to take part in sport and activity when COVID-19 restrictions enable them to do so.

Support is still available from the Joint Sports Hardship Fund

The Carlisle Sports Hardship and Restart Fund helps local clubs to ensure that a return to sporting activity is as safe as possible for volunteers and participants. We will continue to prioritise not for profit sporting organisations which have reducing financial resources resulting in hardship due to the pandemic.
