Places of Worship Protective Security Funding Scheme Opens for Bids

Grants are available to provide protective security measures to places of worship in England and Wales that have been subject to or are vulnerable to hate crimes that target people because of their religion.

TDS Charitable Foundation

Funding is available for organisations that support landlords and tenants to improve standards and educate those involved in the private rented sector in England, Wales and Northern Ireland.

Tesco Bags of Help Grants Programme

A standalone capital grant offering funding to farmers and other land managers in England to plant and protect young trees. The grant provides a one-off payment towards the cost of supplying and planting trees and associated items needed to create new woodland.

Government Launches £40m Clean Growth Fund for Green Start-ups

A fund has been set up as a venture capital vehicle to accelerate early-stage green businesses in the UK.
