Arts Council England - Capital Investment Programme

Capital funding is available to support cultural organisations in England to adjust buildings and equipment so that they can operate safely post-pandemic, improve access, seize on technological opportunities, and reduce environmental impact. The online Expression of Interest form will be available between noon on 5 October 2021 and noon on 26 October 2021.

October Deadline for PRS Foundation's Open Fund for Music Organisations

Grants are available for any not-for-profit organisation based in the UK to support new music projects led by promoters, large performance groups, talent development organisations, venues, festivals and curators in the UK. **The deadline for applications is 18 October 2021**.

International Dylan Thomas Prize Open to Applications

Worldwide competition open to young writers of any nationality to recognise exceptional literary work. **The closing date for entries to the 2022 Prize is Monday 8 November 2021.**

Partner-Up Fund

Countryside Stewardship Facilitation Fund to Reopen in December

A fund designed to encourage collaboration and peer-to-peer learning for the protection and enhancement of local landscapes in England is reopening later this year. Applications for the sixth round of the Fund will be invited from December, with a closing date of 19 January 2022.

NHS Opens £680m Unified Tech Fund

Government has launched a £680 million funding package available to NHS organisations and health care partnerships across England to support technology projects. **Each fund has its own application deadline.** NHS organisations and health care partnerships are eligible to apply. Eligibility varies depending on which fund is selected, so applicants must check the guidance for the specific fund to ensure they meet the criteria.

Partner-Up Fund

Grants are available to partnerships of organisations with shared ideas for innovative arts projects that seek to bring about social change and forge strong connections across communities. **The programme will open to Expressions of Interest on 5 October 2021.**

Sir Jules Thorn Charitable Trust -Hospice Fund
