### **Applications Invited to PRS Foundation's Open Fund for Music Organisations**

Funding is available for not-for-profit organisations based in the UK to support new music projects led by promoters, large performance groups, talent development organisations, venues, festivals and curators.

The deadline for applications is 15 March 2022 (6pm).

### **National Lottery Heritage Fund Launches Dynamic Collections Campaign**

Museums (accredited and non-accredited), archives, historic libraries and community organisations which hold collections across the UK can now apply for new Lottery funding to help build resilience in the heritage sector.

Applications are accepted on a rolling basis until 31 March 2022.

## **Communities - Urban & Rural Development**

### **Active Communities Funding Now Available in Parts of Scotland**

Active Communities is a funding programme for community groups and not-for-profit organisations, with an income of less than £350,000 a year or an average of £350,000 over two years, seeking investment of between £5,000 and £40,000 for projects lasting up to two years.

The Active Communities funding opportunity is now open in parts of Scotland. Applications for funding will close on Wednesday 3 March at 1pm.

### **Community Gardens Award Accepting Applications**

Set up in 2011 in memory of the writer and gardener Elspeth Thompson, the Community Gardens Award offers grants for projects run by amateur garden groups with a community focus across England and Wales.

The deadline to apply is 28 February 2022.

### **Government Opens Windrush Day Grant Scheme for 2022 Applications**

The Windrush Day Grant Scheme is part of the Government's work to create more resilient communities, where different religions, cultures and opinions are celebrated, underpinned by a shared set of values that champion tolerance, freedom and equality of opportunity.

The deadline to apply is 18 March 2022.

### **New Grants for Under-Represented Groups within the LGBT+ Community**

With funds from the National Lottery Community Fund, the Consortium of Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual and Transgender Voluntary and Community Organisations (Consortium) has launched a new programme which aims to build capacity and resilience in grassroots LGBT+ community groups across England.

Applications are accepted on a rolling basis until 30 October 2022.

## Energy, Environment and Climate

### **Countryside Stewardship Grants Open for 2023 Agreements**

England's farmers, foresters and land managers can now apply for various funds under the 2023 Countryside Stewardship scheme to help them protect the environment.

The next application window for the Countryside Stewardship (CS) scheme is now open, providing a chance for more farmers and land managers in England to prepare for the future and receive payment for environmental work, alongside sustainable food production.

### **Funding to Support Community Rewilding Projects Across Britain**

Community groups, public, and private landowners in England, Scotland, and Wales can apply for funding to develop or scale-up rewilding projects on land or at sea.

The deadline for this round of applications is 31 March 2022.

### **JAC Trust Now Accepting Applications for Climate Resilience Grants**

Funding to support forcibly displaced people and their host communities to respond and adapt to climate change.

The deadline to apply is 14 March 2022.

### **Sea-Change Increases Award Size for Marine Preservation Projects in the UK**

Grants of up to £2,500 are available for UK-based not-for-profit organisations to address marine conservation and environmental protection.

The next application deadline for large grants is 31 March 2022.
