Priority Services Register

The Priority Services Register (PSR) is a free service provided by suppliers and network operators to customers in need. Here we explain the help available to you if you sign up. You can receive the services available if you are receiving a pension, have a long-term medical condition, have a hearing or visual impairment or additional communication needs or are in a vulnerable situation. To be added to the Priority Services Register, you simply need to contact your energy supplier. You can find their contact details on your energy bill.
