Funding for Cultural Organisations Across the UK to Recover from Impact of COVID-19

Mid- to large-scale cultural organisations can apply for grants to restart important work, refresh activities, and develop plans to rebuild audiences following closures due to the COVID-19 crisis.

Countryside Productivity Small Grant scheme (CPSG) Round 3 launched!

<u>Cash for Kids - Cumbria and South</u> West Scotland

Grants are available to individuals, registered charities, sports clubs and voluntary and community organisations based in the CFM Radio broadcast area for projects that benefit children and young people who are disabled, disadvantaged or suffering from abuse or neglect and are 18 years or younger.

Happy Days Children's Charity

Funding for families with children aged 3-17 who are disabled, have a special need or have been abused in the UK.



Community Development

Carlisle DEFRA Community Grant

Cumbria County Council has some small scale grants linked to DEFRA funding still available for community based projects and initiatives that will benefit the local area in terms of providing food and / or essential services in response to Covid 19.

CN Group Fund

Grants are available to voluntary and community groups in Cumbria for projects that benefit their community.

Community Partnering Fund

Grants are available for local third sector organisations and community groups in the areas served by Northern Gas Networks and Northern Powergrid for projects that benefit those who are 'hard to reach' or vulnerable.

Cumberland Building Society

Grants are available for charitable, not-forprofit organisations whose work benefits communities in Cumbria, Dumfriesshire, Lancaster, Preston and Haltwhistle.

Postcode Recovery Fund Opens for Applications
