IKEA and Lottery Fund Join Forces to Launch New £1.5m Fund for UK on 30 June

Grants are available for not-for-profit organisations including schools to help improve community spaces and deliver sustainable activities for communities in the UK. The 'Places Called Home' Fund aims to inspire and help people get more involved in their local community as a positive, homely place to be and meet other people. The scheme will open for applications on Wednesday 30 June 2021. It will close upon either the receipt of 1,500 applications or Wednesday 14 July 2021, whichever comes first.

Fund to Help Reduce Loneliness in England Opens 28 June

Grants are available for small local voluntary, community and social enterprise organisations in England that are working to reduce loneliness and isolation by bringing people and communities together as the country recovers from the coronavirus pandemic.

The Local Connections Fund opens for applications on Monday 28 June 2021.

£18m Fund for Higher Technical Education Providers

Funding available to support capacity-building and readiness to deliver new approved Digital Higher Technical Qualifications. Applications must be submitted by the deadline of Friday 9 July 2021 (11.59pm).



Environment, Energy & Climate

Green Heat Network Fund (GHNF) Transition Scheme

Capital grants for public, private and third sector organisations in England to support the development of low and zero carbon heat networks. The GHNF Transition Scheme will open for applications on Monday 5 July 2021. The deadline will be Thursday 12 August 2021 (12pm).

<u>Social Housing Decarbonisation Fund</u> (SHDF)

Registered UK providers of social housing will be able to bid for funding to improve the energy performance of their social homes. Applications for the first wave of funding will open in autumn 2021. Further information on the autumn bidding window will be published later this summer. Funded projects will be those delivered up to March 2023.

Support for England's Councils to Fund Energy Saving Measures in Low Income Households

Local authorities across England can apply for funding to help them install energy saving upgrades and low carbon heating in low-income households. The deadline for applications is Wednesday 4 August 2021 (11.59pm).



Health & Social Welfare

Comic Relief and Government Join Forces to Offer a Digital Fund for Domestic Abuse Charities

Funding for smaller, specialist organisations in England and Wales that support survivors and victims of domestic abuse and sexual violence, who are led 'by, with and for' communities facing racial inequality, disabled people or LGBTQ+ communities.

The deadline for applications is 12noon on Tuesday 20 July 2021.

Princess Royal Respite Fund for Carers

Grants are available for unpaid carers for respite breaks and associated replacement care across the UK. **Application deadline:**None specified
