Learning through Landscapes – Local School Nature Grants

Grants are available to provide outdoor learning training and equipment to schools and early years providers in England, Wales and Scotland.

Triangle Trust Accepting Applications for Young Offender Employment Projects

Funding for not-for-profit projects to help young people with criminal convictions secure meaningful employment in the UK. The deadline for applications is **noon on 26 October 2021**.





Environment, Energy & Climate

A £100 million fund designed to help UK firms capitalise on offshore wind.

Funding is available to help UK businesses undertake projects leading to the commercialisation of products and services in the offshore wind sector. The deadline for applications is **29 October 2021 (5pm)**.

Build UK India - Industrial Net Zero

Funding and a programme of support are available to UK advanced digital technology startups to explore applications of their existing products and services with established Indian corporate partners that hold aspirations in leveraging digital technology, to optimise resource usage and processes. The deadline for applications is **23:59 BST on 10 October 2021**.

Industry of Future Programme (IFP): Industrial Sites Scoping Study Competition

This scheme aims to increase the range of options available to UK industry to enable them to decarbonise at a faster rate. In order to apply to the Scoping Study Competition, applicants must register by 23 September 2021 (12:00 BST). Applicants will then be asked to submit an online application by **14 October 2021 (12:00 BST)**.

MOREhedges

Financial support is available for farmers and landowners in the UK to help them plant more hedges. Application deadline: None specified.

MOREwoods

Financial support is available for farmers and landowners in the UK to help them plant more woodland on a large scale. Application deadline: None specified.

£270m Green Heat Network Fund Launches in Spring 2022

Public, private and third sector organisations in England will be invited to apply for capital funding to help new and existing heat networks move to low and zero carbon technologies. The scheme will open for applications in **April 2022. It is anticipated to run until 2025**.

<u>£9m for New Round of Air Quality Grants</u> Programme

Capital grants are available to local authorities in England to support their air quality responsibilities. The 2021/22 deadline for applications is **8 October 2021**.
