Art Fund Grants to Support the Commission of New Work

Grants are available to support the commission and acquisition of important new work, and exceptional projects with significant public impact.

Art Fund recognise that there are distinct opportunities and fundraising challenges in realising a commission, and that the acquisition of a commission can be conceptualised and carried out in many different ways.

Applications for small grants can be submitted at any time.

Music Export Growth Scheme -New Round Open

Grants are available for independent music companies to showcase UK music projects abroad.

The Music Export Growth Scheme makes grants available to UK-registered independent music companies to assist them with marketing campaigns when looking to introduce successful UK music projects overseas.

The next deadline for applications is 2 September 2022 (11.59pm).

Defra Opens UK Seafood Fund: Skills and Training Scheme

Funding is available for UK based providers of training relevant to the seafood sector.

The UK Seafood Fund: Skills and Training Scheme will provide a one-off fund to improve training in the seafood industry, including the catching, processing and aquaculture sectors.

The deadline for applications to access funding for training courses and specialist equipment is 12 October 2022 (12pm).

Defra Reopens Bids for Fisheries Industry Science Partnerships Scheme

Partnerships between the UK seafood sector and research institutes can now apply for funding towards scientific research projects focused on sustainability within the fisheries and seafood sector.

Interested parties can bid for a contract until 5 September 2022 (12pm).

IUK Announces Women in Innovation Awards 2022-23

Innovation funding, coupled with tailored support, will be awarded to businesswomen in the UK who have enterprising ideas and the potential to become leaders in innovation and deliver economic growth.

Applications will be accepted from 22 August 2022 until 19 October 2022 (11am).

New Round of IUK's Biomedical Catalyst Industry-led R&D Competition

UK businesses and research and technology organisations, working alone or with partners, can apply for funding to develop innovative solutions to health and healthcare challenges.

Applications open on 15 August 2022. The deadline to apply is 12 October 2022 (11am).

Young Entrepreneurs Invited to Apply for 2022 Varsity Pitch Competition

An equity-free cash prize of $\pounds 15,000$ is available for entrepreneurial students and recent graduates across the UK.

The Varsity Pitch Competition rewards UK students and recent graduate entrepreneurs who have enterprising ideas that they wish to turn into viable businesses; enabling participants to showcase their unique, creative ideas to the wider community.

The closing date for applications is Friday 9 September 2022 (12pm).

Funding for Financial and Digital Empowerment Projects

Applications are being accepted by a funding programme designed to help more people in the UK become digitally and financially empowered.

Funding is available to UK charitable organisations for projects to improve people's digital confidence, knowledge and skills to enable them to make more informed decisions about money and have access to financial services.

The deadline for applications is 23 September 2022.

DCMS Launches Media Literacy Programme Fund

Grants are available to organisations undertaking media literacy activity projects in England that tackle a range of media literacy challenges.

The deadline for applications is 19 September 2022 (11.59pm).

New Grants to Boost International Recognition of UK Regulators

Grants are available for UK regulators and professional bodies pursuing international recognition arrangements.

The Recognition Arrangements Grants Programme will provide grants for UK regulators to develop recognition arrangements with their international counterparts, and ensure British professionals have their qualifications recognised overseas.

Expressions of interest for the first round of the programme are open until 16 September 2022 (11.59pm).

Autumn Round of Rewilding Innovation Fund Open for Applications

Community groups, public, and private landowners in England, Scotland, and Wales can apply for funding to develop or scale-up rewilding projects on land or at sea.

Rewilding Britain is offering grants of up to $\pounds 15,000$ to help foster new and ambitious rewilding projects, or scale-up pre-existing projects, across Britain. The Rewilding Innovation Fund will support rewilding projects on land and at sea, at a scale of more than 40 hectares, that adhere to Rewilding Britain's rewilding principles.

The deadline for applications is 14 October 2022.

<u>Transition of England's Woodland</u> <u>Creation Offer to New Local Nature</u> <u>Recovery Scheme</u>

The majority of new applications for Woodland Creation payments from 2025 will be made through the Local Nature Recovery scheme.

Farmers and landowners in England are being encouraged to apply for a share of \pounds 25 million in funding to support woodland creation and tree planting.

Applications may be submitted at any time.
