Funding Focus - Cost of Living



abrdn Financial Fairness Trust NEW FUND

Grants are available for strategic work, including policy work, campaigning and research, which has the potential to improve financial wellbeing at a national scale in the UK, especially for those on low-to-middle incomes.

The funding is intended for strategic work, including policy work, campaigning and research, which has the potential to improve financial wellbeing at a national scale.

The next deadline for applications is 4 February 2023 (1pm).

Asda Foundation - Empowering Local Communities Grant

Grants are available to community groups in the UK to support a broad range of activities which can contribute towards transforming their community and improving the lives of people in their community. This funding round will also support projects that alleviate impacts of the rise in cost of living.

The closing date for Round 3 applications is 11 November 2022.

Asda Foundation Offers Cost of Living Grant to Local Groups Across the UK

Funding to support local community groups who are facing an increase in their running costs (rent, utilities and food costs) between September 2022 and February 2023.

Asda Foundation's new Cost of Living Grant will provide grants of between £500 and £2,000 for

activities taking place before 28 February 2023.

Applications will be accepted by Asda Community Champions the week commencing 19 September 2022 until the budget cap is reached (estimated to be February 2023).

Aviva Community Fund - Cost of Living Boost (with Crowdfunding)

The £2 million Cost of Living Boost scheme is provided by Aviva plc, a British multinational insurance company headquartered in London, as part of its Aviva Community Fund. Aviva is the largest general insurer and a leading life and pensions provider.

Aviva will match donations pound for pound up to $\pounds 250$ between 4 October and 31 December 2022 or until the entire $\pounds 2$ million is allocated.



Funding Focus - Cost of Living



British Gas Energy Trust NEW FUND

Grants are available to individuals and families across Great Britain to be used to write off their energy debts.

British Gas Energy Trust is an independent charitable body set up to support individuals and families who are struggling to pay their bills, regardless of energy provider.

Applications can be made at any time until the funding runs out.

COSARAF – Hardship Grants

Grants are available for third party social organisations to support individuals and families across the UK who are in financial need and have exhausted all other sources of funding.

This fund aims to support individuals and families who are struggling with everyday costs, such as basic living expenses, household items and utilities, or rent arrears.

Applicants must be able to demonstrate that they are taking advantage of all support offered by local services, including the referring social organisation.

Family Action - Welfare Grants Programme

Grants to support families and individuals for essential personal and household needs to assist families and individuals with low incomes, particularly those living on benefits. Family Action aims to support families during times of hardship to enable them to become stronger, happier and healthier.

Applications are accepted any time.

Friends of the Elderly - Grants for Older People


Small grants are available to support older people living on low incomes in England and Wales with the costs of home essentials, unexpected large bills, living costs and getting connected online.

The funding is intended to support older people who are of, or over, state pension age (66 years) and living on low incomes in England or Wales.

Applications can be made at any time and are dealt with in date order.



Funding Focus - Cost of Living



Grants are available for registered charities, social enterprises and constituted charitable groups to help people in the UK when other sources of support have failed, are inappropriate, or are simply not available.

Applications can be submitted at any time. There are no deadlines and applications are assessed as they are received.

Little Lives Children's Community Support Programme

Grants are available for smaller UK community organisations that work with children to help them deliver activities and services.

The aim of the programme is to support smaller organisations that work with children and which may be struggling financially as a result of the coronavirus pandemic.

The next deadline for applications is 30 September 2022.

<u>Sport England: Active Together</u> (with Crowdfunding)

Grants are available for not-for-profit community sport and physical activity groups in England who can raise their initial funding through a crowdfunding campaign to support those experiencing financial difficulty due to Covid-19, the emerging energy, cost of living or other local crisis.

The funding is intended to help sport and physical activity organisations to move forward with priority projects and running costs that they might be struggling with due to the pandemic or the cost-of-living crisis or other local crisis situations such as adverse weather.

Young Foundation Offering Grants for Research and Innovation

Funded by UK Research and Innovation (UKRI), the Community Knowledge Fund seeks to foster stronger community connections to research and knowledge sharing.

The deadline to apply is 7 November 2022.



Children & Young People

Second Round of Youth Music Catalyser Fund Opens for Applications

The second round of a strategic funding programme to support organisations delivering music projects for young people in England is accepting applications.

Funding is available to UK based organisations who are running music projects in England for children and young people (aged 25 or under) to sustain work, scale-up delivery, or create change in sector practice.

The deadline for Expressions of Interest for Round Two is 4 November 2022 (5pm).





Education, Employment & Training

Education Endowment Foundation Opens Autumn Funding Round

Grants are available to organisations to help raise the standards of underperforming schools in England.

The Education Endowment Foundation (EEF) grant funding tests the impact of high-potential projects aiming to raise the attainment and wider outcomes of 3 - 18 year-olds, particularly those from disadvantaged backgrounds.

The deadline for applications to the autumn 2022 funding round is 30 November 2022.



Energy, Environment and Climate

Innovate UK Announces Net Zero Living: Pioneer Places Competition

UK businesses and local authorities can apply grants to plan for a place-based demonstration of ways to accelerate progress towards net zero.

Through this programme, Innovate UK will invest in projects for local authorities and businesses to develop detailed local plans for innovative approaches to the delivery of net zero targets.

Applications open on 26 October 2022 and close on 30 November 2022.

Launch of Industrial Energy Transformation Fund - Phase 2 Autumn 2022

Funding is available to help businesses in England, Wales and Northern Ireland with high energy use reduce their carbon outputs.

The Industrial Energy Transformation Fund (IETF) supports industrial sites with high energy use to transition to a low carbon future.

The deadline for applications to be submitted is 13 January 2023. This is the last currently planned application window.

The deadline for applications is the 24 November 2022.



Transport, Infrastructure & Communications

Phase 2 Launch of IUK's £20m Hydrogen Transport Hub Demonstration Competition

UK businesses and collaborations can access grants to demonstrate how green hydrogen can be used to power transport solutions for end users.

Innovate UK (IUK) is awarding funding to create a long-term sustainable demand for hydrogen from transport and to de-risk hydrogen's adoption for transport owners and operators.

The application deadline for both strands is 30 November 2022.
