

THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (FOOTPATH NO.109136 IN THE CITY OF CARLISLE)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS) ORDER 2020

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable Network Plus to carry out the works to install a new underground link box (“the Works”), the County Council of Cumbria intends to make an Order the effect of which is to prohibit pedestrians from proceeding along that section of Footpath No.109136 in the City of Carlisle from a point adjacent to 33 Cartmel Drive extending for its entire length to its junction with Footpath No. 109264.

A suitable alternative route for pedestrians will be available via Footpath No’s 109135, 109134 and 109264.

The Order will come into operation on 17 August 2020 and may continue in force for a period of up to six months from that date as and when the appropriate traffic signs are displayed, although it is anticipated that it will only be required for **5 days**.

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS) ORDER 2020

WHEREAS the County Council of Cumbria (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) being the traffic authority for Footpath No. 109136 in the City of Carlisle is satisfied that pedestrian traffic in the said road should be restricted by reason of works being proposed to be executed thereon (“the Works”).

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of their powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf hereby make the following Order.

1. No person shall proceed along that section of Footpath No.109136 in the City of Carlisle from a point adjacent to 33 Cartmel Drive, Carlisle extending for its entire length to its junction with Footpath No. 109264.
2. Nothing in this Order shall apply other than at such times and to such extent as is indicated by the appropriate traffic signs.
3. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
4. This Order shall come into operation on the seventeenth day of August 2020 and may be cited as The County of Cumbria (Footpath No.109136 in the City of Carlisle) (Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrians) Order 2020.
