Partner-Up Fund

Grants are available to partnerships of organisations with shared ideas for innovative arts projects that seek to bring about social change and forge strong connections across communities. The programme will open to Expressions of Interest on 5 October 2021.



Business, Enterprise & Regeneration

New Round of Small Business Builders COVID-19 Recovery Grants

Grants are available to small businesses to help them emerge successfully from the ongoing coronavirus pandemic. For the current round, applications must be submitted by the deadline of 15 October 2021.

New Round of Funding for Entrepreneurs Setting up Rural Firms

Funding is being offered to help entrepreneurs start new businesses in rural areas of the UK. The deadline for applications is 25 October 2021 (12:00 BST).

Industrial Energy Transformation Fund Phase 2: Autumn 2021 Window Now Open

Communities - Urban & Rural Development

Armed Forces Covenant Fund Trust -Force for Change Programme

Grants for local community projects that reduce isolation and promote integration; supporting post-COVID recovery in local Armed Forces communities affected by isolation. This year (2021), the programme will support ideas that need small amounts of funding to deliver nimble and focused local projects to Armed Forces communities or small grants to support services, projects and activities that are used by Armed Forces communities, but which are struggling as a result of the impact of the Covid pandemic. **Round 3 - deadline of midday on 19 November 2021 with a decision by 28 February 2022**.

Aviva Community Fund Support for Smaller UK Projects

A public initiative is inviting community groups in the UK to put forward their project ideas. The deadline for applications for the latest round of funding is 11.59pm on 5 October 2021.

Comic Relief Community Fund for England Invites 2021 Applications

Funding for local community groups who are driving change by drawing on the expertise of people with lived experience of the issues being tackled. **The deadline is 29 November 2021, but the fund may close earlier if enough applications are received**.

Cumberland Building Society Community Fund

BBC Children in Need Emergency Essentials Programme

Funding for the purchase of essential items to meet the most basic needs of children and young people in the UK who are facing exceptionally difficult circumstances. **Application deadline: None specified**

Funding for Children's Cycle Training in England

Funding available to current Bikeability training providers and organisations for innovative pilot projects that encourage underrepresented children in England to take part in cycle training. **The deadline for applications is 29 October 2021 (5pm)**.

Youth Endowment Fund and Comic Relief Invite Applications to £10m Fund

Funding for up to 10 projects in England and Wales to create a supportive home environment for young people to help keep them safe from involvement in violence. Grants are available to charities, public services or private sector organisations delivering programmes in England and Wales. The funder will be looking for applications that help answer this question:

"Which approaches are most effective in helping families and carers to create a supportive home environment for 6- to 14-year-old children (including looked-after children), reducing the likelihood of them becoming involved in violence?" **The deadline for applications is 1 December 2021**.



Digital, Information & Technology

NHS Opens £680m Unified Tech Fund

Government has launched a £680 million funding package available to NHS organisations and health care partnerships across England to support technology projects. **Each fund has its own application deadline.** NHS organisations and health care partnerships are eligible to apply. Eligibility varies depending on which fund is selected, so applicants must check the guidance for the specific fund to ensure they meet the criteria.
