### Arts Council England Releases First Details of National Portfolio for 2023 Onwards

Arts and cultural organisations in England will soon be able to apply to join the National Portfolio and contribute to creative and cultural provision across the country.

Full guidelines will be available on the Arts Council England website in January 2022.

### Arts Council England Releases Details of Queen's Jubilee Fund

Funding for not-for-profit groups delivering creative and cultural activities which commemorate the Platinum Jubilee in England.

Applications will open on 4 January 2022 with deadlines published on local Community Foundation websites across the UK.

### <u>Funding for Black, Asian and</u> <u>'Global Majority' Artists to Perform at</u> <u>Edinburgh Fringe</u>

Funding is being provided to help Black, Asian and 'Global Majority' artists across the UK to overcome barriers that would otherwise prevent them from performing at the Edinburgh Festival Fringe.

The deadline for applications is 17 January 2022 (10am).

#### Playwrights Invited to Enter 2022 Papatango New Writing Prize

A playwriting award has opened to applications for new scripts in 2022.

The 2022 Prize is open for entries until Sunday 30 January 2022 (9pm).

Commercialising Quantum Technologies -IUK Announces Round 3 Feasibility Studies Competition

Funding is available for UK-based, business-led feasibility and industrial research projects to advance the commercialisation of quantum technologies in the UK.

The competition opens on Monday 17 January 2022. The deadline for applications will be Wednesday 9 March 2022 (11am).

#### Countdown to Take Off - Carol Vorderman Backs Starling Bank Business Grants

This competition offers a chance for small UK firms, with Starling Bank business accounts, to win cash grants to boost their operations.

Start-up founders from across the UK are being supported to create tech solutions for global social and environmental problems.

The deadline for applications is 9 January 2022 (11.59pm).

### England's Countryside Stewardship Facilitation Fund Opens to New Bids

A fund designed to encourage collaboration and peer-to-peer learning for the protection and enhancement of local landscapes in England is open to new applications.

The deadline to apply for the 2022 round of Facilitation funding is 19 January 2022. Agreements will run from 1 June 2022 for three years.
