

Review of Polling Districts and Polling Places

The Review of Polling Districts and Polling Places (Parliamentary Elections) Regulations 2006

Carlisle City Council is carrying out a review of polling districts and polling places as required by the above Regulations.

Comments are invited from electors and other interested parties on any aspect of polling districts and/or polling places currently used in the Carlisle Constituency and that part of the Penrith and the Border Constituency that lies within the City Council's area. The review will also look at the suitability of existing polling stations and consider any suggested alternatives.

The Returning Officers comments on proposed polling stations and information about the current polling arrangements can be found on the Council's website at www.carlisle.gov.uk or by contacting Electoral Services at the Civic Centre, Carlisle or telephoning 01228 817555.

Representations and comments are invited from electors within the authority area or from within the Parliamentary Constituency of Carlisle or Penrith and the Border should be sent in writing to the Returning Officer at the address below or by e-mail to elections@carlisle.gov.uk by 1st November 2013. The authority would welcome comments or representations from any person or body with expertise in access for persons with any type of disability. Persons or bodies making representations should, if possible, give alternative places that may be used as polling places. All correspondence, comments, proposals and other documents will be available for inspection on completion of the review. It is envisaged that the report on the outcome of the review will be submitted to the City Council for consideration in January 2014.
