

CUMBERLAND COUNCIL CARLISLE REMEMBRANCE PARADE ORDER 2023

ORDER UNDER SECTION 21 OF THE TOWN POLICE CLAUSES ACT 1847 FOR THE PREVENTION OF OBSTRUCTION ETC

WHEREAS during certain hours from **Friday 10th November 2023 to Sunday 12th November 2023** certain highways in the area of the Cumberland Authority will be thronged and liable to obstruction for the purpose of a Parade. Cumberland Council pursuant to powers conferred by Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 and all other enabling powers do hereby order and direct that for the purpose of preventing obstruction in the said highways the following regulations shall be observed:

- 1. That during the period from 10:45am to 12:00pm on 10th November 2023 ("the First Date") that highway or road or length of highway or road (adopted as maintainable at the public expense) known as Castle Street commencing from its junction with St Mary's Gate to its junction with The Green Market and that area of the Town Centre known as the Green Market shown coloured orange on the plan attached hereto and marked "Plan 1" ("Plan 1") shall be closed to all classes of vehicular traffic, except emergency vehicles.
- 2. That during the period from 10:45am to 12:00pm on 12th November 2023 ("the Second Date") the following:
 - a) that highway or road or length of highway or road (adopted as maintainable at the public expense) comprising of Eastbound and Westbound carriageways of the A595 known as Castle Way commencing from the Castle directly across Castle Way to its junction with Castle Street shown coloured orange on the plan attached hereto and marked "Plan 2" ("Plan 2") will be closed to vehicular traffic for two periods of approximately 15 minutes between 10:45 hours and 1105 hours and between 11:30 hours and 12:00 hours:
 - b) That highway or roads or length of highway or road (adopted as maintainable at the public expense) known as Castle Street from its junction with Finkle Street and Annetwell Street to its junction with The Green Market and that area of the Town Centre known as the Green Market shown coloured orange on Plan 1 will be closed to vehicular traffic between 10:45 hours and 11:10 hours and between 11:30 hours and 12:00 hours:
 - c) That highway or roads or length of highway or road (adopted as maintainable at the public expense) known as Finkle Street from its junction with Castle Street to its junction with Annetwell will be closed to vehicular traffic between 10:45 hours and 11:10 hours and between 11:30 hours and 12:00 hours;

- d) That highway or road or length of highway or road (adopted as maintainable at public expense) known as Annetwell Street from its junction with Castle Street to its junction with Finkle Street will be closed to vehicular traffic between 10:45 hours and 11:05 hours and between 11:30 hours and 12:00 hours.
- 3. Nothing in this Order shall apply to anything done under the direction of or with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer nor shall prejudice any right on the part of the highway or other appropriate Authority to take proceedings for any infringement, incursion or obstruction of any footpath or highway under the Highways Act 1980 or any other applicable enactment or the common law.
- 4. All persons with a vehicle will accordingly have to take alternative routes as appropriate other than those specified in this Order between the times specified therein on the Date.
- 5. This Order will come into operation at **10:30am** on the Date and may be cited as the Cumberland Council Carlisle Remembrance Parade Order 2023.
- 6. Any wilful breach of this Order by any person shall be an offence against the above Act and every person committing any such offence shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale being £1,000.
