Covid 19: Business Discretionary Grant Fund - closing date 15 June 2020

The Local Authority Small Business
Discretionary Grant is aimed at small
businesses who are not eligible for other
government coronavirus grants. Businesses
who have applied for the Coronavirus Job
Retention Scheme and the Self-Employed
Income Support Scheme are eligible to
apply for this scheme.

Dairy Farmers Coronavirus Hardship Response Fund

Eligible English dairy farmers will be able to apply for up to £10,000 to overcome the impact of coronavirus from 18 June.

Forward Advances

A revenue-based finance solution for start-ups and fast-growing businesses in the UK.

Self-Employment Support Scheme Extended and Furlough Scheme Amended

The self-employed will be able to claim a second grant in August, and the furlough scheme will be more flexible, bringing employees back part time in July, with employers contributing to salaries from August.





Children & Young People

<u>Asda Foundation - COVID-19 Healthy</u> <u>Holiday Grants</u>

Grants are available to support charitable groups that typically would be holding summer holiday activities to ensure vulnerable children are provided with a hot meal.

Hargreaves Foundation

Grants are available for charities and educational institutions that support those under the age of 18 years, and living with a mental health problem, physical disability or growing up in poverty through the mediums of sport and education.

Fund Launched for Infrastructure Organisations Working to Address Youth Unemployment

Key infrastructure organisations in England that can demonstrate their ability to play a pivotal role in responding to rising youth unemployment but have had their finances impacted as a result of the COVID-19 crisis can now apply for grants.





Community Development

Asda Foundation - COVID-19 Hygiene Grants

Grants are available for care homes, hospices, hospitals and homeless shelters supporting residents/patients in facilities in the UK, who are struggling and unable to provide their own toiletries either through lack of funds or access to family support as a result of the current restrictions.

British Muslim Covid-19 Fund

Grants are available for charities, organisations and voluntary groups in the UK impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic

Coronavirus Community Support Fund

Distributed by The National Lottery
Community Fund, the **Coronavirus Community Support Fund** is open for applications. It is expected that this funding will reach frontline organisations within a few weeks.

Fund Launched for Women's Organisations Impacted by COVID-19 Crisis

Specialist women's organisations across the UK can apply for unrestricted funding to deal with the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on their work.

Schools and community groups can apply for grants for tree planting projects across the UK, preferably taking place during National Tree Week.
