National Lottery Heritage Fund - Steps to Sustainability

Funding and a programme of specialist support are available for small to medium-sized UK heritage organisations to help turn a new business idea into reality.

The round two deadline for applications is 23 July 2021.



Business, Enterprise & Regeneration

Future Fund: Breakthrough

A direct co-investment fund aimed at growth stage innovative, R&D-intensive UK companies seeking relatively large investments.

The scheme is open for applications on a rolling basis.

Launch of £50m Equity Fund to Invest in UK Firms

An equity fund has been created to invest in growth capital for early stage businesses or management buyouts for mid-sized firms across the UK.

Techstars 2022 'Anywhere Accelerator' Open to Companies Worldwide

Entrepreneurs are being supported to commercialise new technologies, with equity funding and supplementary support. Applications for the 2022 Accelerator are now open. **The deadline is 6 October 2021**.

August Deadline for First Round of UK Community Ownership Fund

The UK Government's £150 million Community Ownership Fund is accepting applications. Funding is available to charities and community groups in the UK to support them in taking ownership of local assets such as pubs, theatres and parks.

The Round One deadline for applications is 13 August 2021.

Co-op Community Fridge Fund

Grants are available to non-profit organisations across the UK to establish a new Community Fridge to minimise food waste. The deadline for applications is 16 August 2021 (9am).

ScottishPower Foundation Invites UK Applications for Funding in 2022

Funding for UK registered charities for projects that support education, training, research, biodiversity, climate change, arts, culture, as well as supporting the most vulnerable people and groups in society.

Additional Funding for Tree Nurseries From England & Wales Supplying Scotland

Funding is available for tree nurseries from Great Britain that supply trees to Scotland. One application round will normally be run each year with a closing date of 31 January for the submission of applications. However, an additional application round is being run in 2021 for projects in England and Wales (only), with up to £750,000 of funding available for projects that can be completed by 31 March 2022. The closing date for submission of applications for this round is 31 August 2021.

Applications Invited for Ecosurety Exploration Fund

The second round of a UK-wide fund for recycling initiatives is open for applications.

The deadline for applications is 24 August 2021 (4pm).

Call for Carbon Capture, Usage & Storage (CCUS) Innovation 2.0 Competition

Grant funding is available for projects developing novel technology and processes that reduce the cost of deploying carbon capture, usage and storage (CCUS) technology from UK industry. Those intending to apply must confirm via email to industry.innovation@beis.gov.uk by 31 July 2021 (17:00 BST). Full applications must be submitted by 29 August 2021 (23:59 BST).
