 - large, medium and small
 - unionised and non-unionised
 - public and private

Why Cumbria ?



- 45% people don't meet the recommendations for physical activity
- 30% of residents deemed to be inactive
- 68.3% of Cumbrian's are overweight or Obese (Active People Survey)
- Alcohol costs our economy £200m per year, £400 for every resident
- Life Expectancy inequalities across our region
- Mental Health Issues cost UK £30 Billion in lost time productivity
- 15.1% prevalence of smoking illness, preventable deaths

- Sign up to the appropriate level
- Train up health advocates
- Carry out a Health Needs Assessment
- Create an action plan for the year
- Run activities from HNA
- Implement and EVALUATE any actions
- Collect evidence for the portfolio
- Case study
- Submit the portfolio
- Final assessment visits

Health Advocates



- Remove suspicion from workforce
- Key contact between employer & award co-ordinator
- Interest in health and wellbeing agenda
- Driving force for award programme
- Assist in gathering evidence for portfolio
- Help to identify and progress actions
- Support from line manager
- Help run and organise campaigns
- Signpost to information and support
- Not there to give medical advice
