Arts, Culture & Heritage

Archives Revealed - Scoping Grants 2022 Deadlines Announced

Funding to help archives analyse collections and support the development of future cataloguing projects.

The next deadline is 28 February 2022.



Business, Enterprise & Regeneration

Innovate UK Opens New Round of Smart Grants

Funding is available for organisations to support business-focused, commercially viable R&D innovation that can significantly impact the UK economy.

The deadline for applications to be submitted is 13 April 2022 (11am).





Communities

Smart Energy GB in Communities Fund Opens for New Round

Funding to support the national rollout of smart meters, with a focus on reaching those who may face barriers to engaging with the smart mater rollout.

The deadline to apply is 11 February 2022 (12noon).



Children & Young People

Fund for School Breakfast Clubs across UK Reopens

Schools across the United Kingdom can now apply now for funding to support breakfast club initiatives.

Only one grant per school in each academic year is available.

Applications can be submitted at any time.



Digital & Technology

Geovation Accelerator Programme

Applications are requested from developers, innovators and entrepreneurs, based in the United Kingdom, who have a prototype idea that is related to location information and technology.

The deadline to submit applications is 28 February 2022.

Grants for Technologies Producing Hydrogen from Biomass Now Available

The Government has launched a programme to help develop innovative technologies to produce hydrogen, a clean energy source, from sustainable biomass and waste. The Hydrogen BECCS Innovation Programme will support hydrogen production via bioenergy with carbon capture and storage (BECCS).

The deadline to register for the programme is 4 March 2022 (12noon).





Education, Employment & Training

Fund to Improve Adult Learning through Technology - New Applications Invited

Funding is available for organisations across all sectors undertaking projects that use digital technology to develop new services or improve access and delivery of adult vocational learning in the UK.

There will be two VocTech Seed calls in 2022. The first call is now open with a deadline for applications of 9 February 2022 (5pm).

Funding to Equip Disadvantaged People with Communication Skills for Employment

UK registered charities that are working to develop communication skills for people who want to improve their employment prospects can apply now for funding in Autumn 2022.

There is a two-stage application process.

The deadline for stage one applications is 2 May 2022 for consideration in July.



Energy, Environment and Climate

<u>£100,000 of Funding Available for</u> Communities' Climate Resolutions in 2022

The first round of applications for grants up to \pounds 10,000 are now open for Cumbrian community groups. Environmental charity Cumbria Action for Sustainability (CAfS) recently launched a National Lottery-supported grant funding stream to enable grassroots community groups to take action to tackle climate change.

Applications for amounts of up to £2,000 can be considered at any time, but those groups seeking larger amounts of up to £10,000, in the first round, must apply by Monday 28 February.



Health & Social Welfare

Funding for Projects which Promote Social Inclusion Across the UK

Groups can apply for funding for activities in the areas of housing, employment, mobility and community development.

The deadline to apply is 31 March 2022.

Funding to Support Organisations Working with BME Women and Girls Across England and Scotland

Not-for-profit groups can apply for funding to build capacity and strengthen resilience in tackling violence against women and girls.

The deadline to apply is 10am on 7 February 2022.





Health & Social Welfare

Tackling Loneliness with Transport Fund -Deadline Approaching

Grants available to the public and charity sectors to run pilot transport schemes that aim to reduce loneliness. Deadline for applications is 28 January 2022.

Expressions of interest must be submitted by the deadline of 28 January 2022.
