Arts, Culture & Heritage

Cultural Protection Fund Accepting Applications for Small Grants

Funding to support the protection of cultural heritage under threat in one or more of the Fund's target countries.

Administered by the British Council on behalf of the Department for Digital, Culture, Media and Sport (DCMS), the Fund will support efforts to keep cultural heritage and objects safe as well as providing opportunities for local communities to value, care for and benefit from their cultural heritage.

Expressions of Interest are accepted on a rolling basis, before the application deadline of 31 October 2022.





Arts, Culture & Heritage

September Deadline for PRS Foundation's Open Fund for Music Organisations

Applications are being invited to a fund designed to help support, sustain and promote the growth of the new music infrastructure in the UK.

Funding is available for not-for-profit organisations based in the UK to support new music projects led by promoters, large performance groups, talent development organisations, venues, festivals and curators.

The deadline for applications is 14 September 2022 (6pm).

The Arts Society's Autumn Grant Round Open for Applications

Funding for UK charities to engage young people in the arts, promote skills development in the arts and heritage sector, and support local and regional arts organisations and museums.

The deadline for applications is 30 September 2022.



Business, Enterprise & Regeneration

Innovate UK Launches Analysis for Innovators (A4I) Competition - Round 8

Funding is available for UK-based businesses to work with the best scientists and research facilities to resolve productivity and competitiveness issues.

The deadline for applications for both competition strands is 31 August 2022 (12noon).

Techstars Launches Pre-Accelerator with Audi to Promote Innovation in Mobility

Support is available for mobility-focused entrepreneurs to help them progress their early-stage businesses.

The Techstars and Audi Mobility Pre-Accelerator is a ten-week programme that provides individual founders, with an innovative idea or early-stage company in the mobility space, the training, tools, mentorship, and network to prepare them for the next level. The deadline for applications to be submitted is I November 2022.

UK Global Screen Fund Opens New Round of International Business Development Grants

Funding is available to support independent screen companies across the UK, ensuring a UK-wide benefit and addressing geographic imbalance within the industry.

The International Business Development strand is open for applications until 13 October 2022.





Children & Young People

<u>£368 Million Fund to Improve Youth</u> <u>Services in Underserved Areas Opens for</u> <u>Bids</u>

The scheme is part of government commitment to ensure young people given access to more activities, trips away from home and volunteering opportunities.

The announcement follows 418 youth projects benefiting from $\pounds 12$ million of cash fast-tracked to those in need earlier this year.

Phase 2 of Youth Investment Fund Now Open for Applications

Funding to support the delivery of new and renewed youth facilities within a short timescale.

Applicants must be working with children and young people, where the majority are aged 11 to 19 years. Where young people have a special educational need, are leaving care, or are considered 'at risk' or vulnerable, funding may be granted up to the age of 25 years.

Applications are accepted on a rolling basis, with Grant Committees expected to be held until March 2024.



Communities - Urban & Rural Development

Building Safety Fund Opens to New Applications in England

Owners of high-rise buildings with unsafe cladding in England can now apply for funding to meet the costs of making their properties safe.

The Government originally announced the Building Safety Fund in the Budget on 11 March 2020, to fund the remediation of cladding on high-rise residential buildings over 17.7 metres tall in England.

The deadline for new applications is 1 January 2025.





Communities - Urban & Rural Development

Grants Available for Great Big Green Week Events

Community groups can be awarded up to £300 to host community events during Great Big Green Week (GBGW) 24th September - 2nd October 2022.

CAfS can provide up to £300 of funding for venue hire, publicity materials, speaker expenses, film hire, other activities and equipment. Any surplus generated through donations should be retained by your group.



Education, Employment & Training

Outdoor Learning Grants for Schools and Early Years Providers Across Great Britain

Schools and early years providers in England, Scotland, and Wales can apply for training and resources to promote outdoor learning and make environmental improvements for the benefit of pupils, staff, and the local community.

The next deadline is 2 September 2022 for a decision by 16 September 2022.

Support for Training in Ecclesiastical Heritage Skills Across UK and Ireland

Registered Christian charities throughout the UK and Ireland can apply for funding to support individuals who are training in Heritage skills deemed necessary for the preservation and maintenance of historic Christian buildings.

Applications can be made at any time.



Energy, Environment & Climate

Sainsbury's Announces £5m Investment Programme for Sustainable Tech Start-ups

Support is available for small start-up businesses in the UK that are pioneering sustainable technologies to reduce carbon emissions and help Sainsbury's to achieve its net zero target.

Submissions of interest in the programme may be made at any time.





Health & Social Welfare

New Government Grants to Tackle Homelessness and Rough Sleeping

The fund seeks transformative projects to deliver quality services for individuals experiencing rough sleeping in England.

The Department for Levelling Up, Housing and Communities (DLUHC), in partnership with Housing Justice and Homeless Link, has announced £10 million of funding until 2025 to address homelessness and improve Night Shelter provision across England.

The deadline to apply is 26 August 2022, for notifications in October 2022.
