**Funding body:** Department for Digital, Culture, Media and Sport (DCMS)

**Max. value:** £ 30,000

**Application deadline:** 10/11/2020

### **Smallwood Trust - COVID-19 Frontline Women's Fund**

Grants are available for women's organisations and services in England that are supporting women who are experiencing poverty and low income as a result of the coronavirus/COVID-19 pandemic.

**Funding body:** National Lottery Community Fund

**Max. value:** £ 25,000
