Deadline Alert

Final Week to Apply for Government Portion of Coronavirus Community Support Fund

Groups in England have until 12noon on 17 August to get in their application for emergency grants funded by the government to support people and communities affected by coronavirus.

Imminent deadline for Heritage Culture Recovery Fund - 17 August

Final few days to apply for funding to support organisations across the heritage ecosystem that were financially sustainable before COVID-19, have exhausted all other financing options, and are now at risk of failure.
