Arts Council England Project Grants Re-Open for Applications

After suspending the National Lottery Project Grants programme in March 2020 due to the coronavirus crisis, Arts Council England is re-opening the programme for applications today, aiming to support individuals and organisations to get activities up and running again.



Community Development

Alpkit Foundation – Grassroots Support Now

Grants are available for organisations serving those affected by the coronavirus outbreak.

Comic Relief Community Fund -Project Delivery Grant

Grants are available for small local grassroots organisations in England to support projects that deliver against one of Comic Relief's four strategic themes.

Denise Cohen Charitable Trust

Grants are available to charitable organisations carrying out general charitable purposes in the UK. Funding is at the discretion of the Trust. In the past grants have ranged from £250 to £1,000 with the occasional larger grant being awarded.

Funding to Support Mental Health and Wellbeing of UK Veterans

Armed Forces charities may submit their funding application now for projects and activities that support the mental health and wellbeing of veterans throughout the UK.

Additional funds allocated through The National Lottery Community Fund

TNL has announced the distribution of £45mil to partner organisations through External Delegated Agreement's (EDAs). In developing our Covid-19 crisis response we recognised that we could get support to some organisations and communities more quickly and efficiently by partnering with specialist organisations to distribute funding to them on our behalf.

British Muslim Covid-19 Fund

Charities, and voluntary groups and organisations in the UK are welcome to apply, irrespective of faith. Small grants (up to £1,000) are intended for community groups, grassroots organisations, food banks and other volunteer groups.

Comic Relief COVID-19 Community Fund

Grants are available for small local grassroots organisations in England to provide emergency relief in their communities during the coronavirus crisis and also recover from the impact that the crisis has had on their services.

Commissioner's Covid-19 Community Recovery Fund helping where it is needed most

The Covid-19 Community Recovery Fund is specifically for local charities, community and voluntary groups within Cumbria to help them manage the new issues which are arising in light of the coronavirus pandemic and as restrictions ease.

Community Match Challenge Fund Accepting Applications from Charitable Grant Making Organisations

An £85 million match funding scheme has launched to support those who are most vulnerable and hardest hit by the COVID-19 pandemic in England. Applications will be accepted until Sunday 2 August 2020 for funds raised over a six-week period (from 18 July until 31 August).

Grants are available to enable Christian organisations to adapt to the challenges and opportunities presented by the coronavirus crisis.

Tesco Bags of Help COVID-19 Communities Fund

Grants are available to support a wide range of community groups, charities, schools and other not-for-profit organisations who are supporting vulnerable groups as part of their coronavirus emergency response in supporting local communities.
