Grants for charities and social enterprises in England occupying historic buildings to develop new business plans and strategies in light of the coronavirus/COVID-19 crisis.

#### New Funding Round of History Makers Award for Museums

Grants available to museums in England to fund new exhibitions that will inspire the public through the lives and achievements of extraordinary, historical figures.

#### New Support for England's Artists and Creative Practitioners

This development fund is designed to support independent creative practitioners and ensure excellence is thriving in England's arts and culture sector.

#### £500m Film and TV Production Restart Scheme Now Open

This fund is designed to help film and television production companies that are unable to obtain coronavirus insurance recommence their activities.

#### Defra Launch Darwin/Illegal Wildlife Trade COVID-19 Rapid Response Round

Funding available to respond to the immediate impact of COVID-19 on the priorities of the Darwin Initiative, Darwin Plus and the Illegal Wildlife Trade Challenge Fund (IWTCF).





#### **Business & Enterprise**

#### Barclays Announces £14 Billion Dedicated SME Fund

Loan funding is available to help small and medium businesses in the UK invest for the future.

#### **Business Enterprise Fund Revive Loans**

Loans available to SME businesses across the North East and North West of England, North and West Yorkshire, Humberside and North Lincolnshire who require additional funding to develop and grow.

#### **Business Enterprise Fund Thrive Loans**

Loans available to businesses across the North East and North West of England, North and West Yorkshire, Humberside and North Lincolnshire who are looking to grow.

#### Job Support Scheme Expanded for Businesses Forced to Close by COVID Restrictions

Grants are available for UK registered micro, small and medium-sized enterprises aspiring to transform food production through experimental development projects that are closer to market.

#### <u>£3m to Support Community Businesses</u> in England Affected by COVID-19

Established community businesses in England will be able to apply for unrestricted grants to help them adapt to the challenges moving forward as the country moves into the next phase of the pandemic.

£1 million fund available to higher education providers in England to develop and implement projects which provide innovative approaches to improving mental health outcomes for students.

Funding for Black, Asian and Minority Ethnic (BAME) community groups and organisations that are working to deliver COVID-19 services.

#### Isla Foundation – Immediate Impact Grants

Grants are available for voluntary and community organisations, schools and PTAs, clubs and societies, and entrepreneurial individuals in the UK for small-scale, short-term projects that create a positive change in people's lives and in their communities.

#### Power to Change - Community Business Renewal Fund - next round opens 3 November 2020
