Culture Recovery Fund for Heritage

Grants for cultural and heritage organisations in England to make the transition from lockdowns and social distancing to resume business activity and welcome visitors back to the country's diverseheritage sites starting in April 2021.

Funding and supplementary support for original ideas and emerging talent in the UK filmmaking industry

The scheme's first £5,000 funding pot is open for applications. Applicants may apply for it in part, or all of it. In addition, Grey Moth will consider applicants that can benefit from its mentorship, labour, resources and equipment as contributions in kind.

New Jobs for Young People - Simplified Kickstart Scheme Goes Live

A scheme helping young people into work and spurring Britain's economic revival from COVID-19 has been tweaked, opening it up to more employers.

£200,000 Broadband Competition for Event Venues - Round Two Opens

Funding for business conference centres across the UK to improve broadband infrastructure, thereby, attracting more business visits and events by making destinations across the UK more attractive to international event organisers.

Communities

The Prince's Countryside Fund Opens for Applications from 2 February until enough eligible applications have been received

Rural communities from across the UK can apply for grants of up to £10,000 thanks to support from Barclays, but they need to respond quickly as applications will only be accepted from 2 February until enough eligible applications have been received.



Environmental & Climate

Countryside Stewardship: Woodland Creation Grant

A standalone capital grant offering funding to farmers and other land managers in England to plant and protect young trees. The grant provides a one-off payment towards the cost of supplying and planting trees and associated items needed to create new woodland.

LDF Small Grants open for applications closing date Monday 22 February

Grants of up to £500 will be available to projects delivered in Cumbria supporting community and volunteer-led groups, delivering practical conservation, ideally with a youth focus.

Money Saving Expert (MSE) Charity Opens for Applications

MSE Charity is currently accepting UK applications to its 'Raising the Next Generation' theme but will close as soon as 40 applications are accepted so groups should not wait to apply.
