Moto in the Community Funding for Local **Projects**

Grants are available for community organisations and schools operating within a 15-mile radius of a Moto site for projects and activities that deliver benefits to local communities. Applications may be made at any time and will be considered on a monthly basis.

Funding for local projects that help Armed Forces communities across the UK reduce loneliness or isolation and improve wellbeing as the nation recovers from the COVID-19 pandemic. The deadline for the second round is Monday 2 August 2021 with decisions in late October 2021.

A major new multi-million pound tree planting grant to provide greater financial incentives for England's landowners and farmers to plant and manage trees.

Interested parties can apply year-round.
