The market cross dates from 1682 and symbolises the authority vested in the city by royal charters (dated and inscribed Joseph Reed Mayor 1682). It replaced a similar medieval cross. Circular flight of 5 steps [6<sup>th</sup> now buried] from the centre of which rises a pillar surmounted by a lion sitting holding a scroll with the city arms; sundial faces on top of pillar.  
Owned/maintained by City Council. In good condition, major repairs /refurbished August 2009. Additional work to add support to base in March 2012.

MARKET CROSS GREENMARKET



The Statue of James Steel was erected in 1859 and is situated opposite *Marks and Spencers* on English Street. The statue consists of a granite pedestal with base and a Carrara marble figure. Owned/maintained by City Council. In good condition – cleaned in 2008. Given light clean and lime shelter coat in 2011.

Stone pine cone on stone plinth located on the village green to commemorate the new millennium. Good condition.

WREAY MILLENNIUM PINE CONE



Stone statue on stone plinth with inscribed and gilded plaque, located in front of the courts in Earl Street. Fair condition. Maintained by Cumbria County Council.

MAJOR AGLIONBY STATUE



Cast bronze statue of former Carlisle United player Hugh McIlmoyle erected to celebrate the centenary of the club in 2005. Located at the Warwick Road entrance to the ground. In good condition and maintained by Carlisle United football club.

HUGH McILMOYLE STATUE



Cast bronze statue commemorating the history of the border reivers located outside the Reiver Court apartment building in Scotland Road, Carlisle, erected in 2003 by Story Construction. In good condition and maintained by Story Construction.

BORDER REIVER STATUE



Cumberland and Westmorland war memorial, built in 1922, design by Sir Robert Lorimer. Large blocks of Shap granite ashlar with carvings of regimental badges and carved frieze. Good condition – scheduled for cleaning and repair in 2014. Maintained by Carlisle City Council.

THE CENOTAPH RICKERBY PARK



Unveiled by the Bishop of Carlisle in November 1990, constructed of polished granite, located in the Greenmarket in the city centre pedestrian area. Good condition. Maintained by Carlisle City Council.

THE CENOTAPH GREENMARKET





Freestanding granite obelisk with surrounding railings located on the roadside north of London Road near Petteiril Bridge. Maintained by Carlisle City Council  
Good condition

HARRABY WAR MEMORIAL LONDON ROAD



The memorial is a granite celtic style cross with carved sword, there are 15 names listed. The cross is located in the garden of Botcherby Community Centre. Maintained by Carlisle City Council.  
Good condition

BOTCHERBY WAR MEMORIAL VICTORIA ROAD



Marble plaque inscribed with the names of members of the Howie Boyd Hall, a mission hall attached to Warwick Road Presbyterian Church, who serves and those who were killed in WW1. The plaque is now located in a garden at Bishop Goodwin Primary School. In good condition and maintained by the school.

HOWIE BOYD HALL MEMORIAL



Bronze plaque inscribed with names of soldiers from the 24<sup>th</sup> (Westmorland and Cumberland) Company, 8<sup>th</sup> Battalion Imperial Yeomanry who fought in the Boer War, located in the Museum of Military Life in Carlisle Castle. In good condition, maintained by the museum.

24<sup>th</sup> (CUMBERLAND AND WESTMORLAND) COMPANY BOER WAR MEMORIAL



Roll of Honour in a timber frame commemorating the service of Carlisle City Police employees in WW1, originally located in the West Walls Police Station and now located in the Museum of Military Life in Carlisle Castle. In good condition, maintained by the museum.

CARLISLE CITY POLICE WAR MEMORIAL



Marble plaque commemorating the sacrifice of local men in WW1, originally located in the Toc H (an international charitable movement originating from a WW1 soldiers club) building in Cockermouth and now located in the Museum of Military Life in Carlisle Castle. In good condition, maintained by the museum.

WAR MEMORIAL FROM COCKERMOUTH TocH





This bronze plaque came from the old Wesleyan Chapel in Embleton near Cockermouth and commemorates local men who fought and died in WW1. It is now located in the Museum of Military Life in Carlisle Castle. In good condition, maintained by the museum.

WAR MEMORIAL FROM EMBLETON CHAPEL



Roll of Honour memorial to those from Maryport who served in WW1, from the Loyal Excelsior Lodge of Oddfellows in Maryport and now located in the Museum of Military Life in Carlisle Castle. In good condition, maintained by the museum.

WAR MEMORIAL FROM THE LOYAL EXCELCIOR LODGE OF ODDFELLOWS IN MARYPORT



Marble plaque from the Church of Christ in King Street, Workington commemorating the sacrifice of church members killed in WW1, now located in the Museum of Military Life in Carlisle Castle. In good condition, maintained by the museum.

WAR MEMORIAL FROM THE CHURCH OF CHRIST IN KING STREET, WORKINGTON



Bronze Plaque originally located in the drill hall in Strand Road, Carlisle commemorating the men of the 1 / 4<sup>th</sup> Battalion The Border Regiment who died in service during WW1. The is now located in the Duke of Lancaster's Regiment County HQ in Carlisle Castle, it is in good condition and is maintained by the regiment.

STRAND ROAD CARLISLE DRILL HALL 1/4<sup>TH</sup> BORDER REGIMENT MEMORIAL



Bronze Plaque originally located in the drill hall in Strand Road, Carlisle commemorating the men of the 2 / 4<sup>th</sup> Battalion The Border Regiment who died in service during WW1. The is now located in the Duke of Lancaster's Regiment County HQ in Carlisle Castle, it is in good condition and is maintained by the regiment.

STRAND ROAD CARLISLE DRILL HALL 2/4<sup>TH</sup> BORDER REGIMENT MEMORIAL



The monument is a six-sided obelisk with a marble plaque on each side of the plinth inscribed with names, located in the war graves area of Carlisle Cemetery. Maintained by Carlisle City Council, in good condition, professionally cleaned May 2014.

CARLISLE CEMETERY WW1 WAR MEMORIAL RICHARDSON STREET



Portland stone Cross of Sacrifice with bronze sword mounted on a tiered Portland stone base, located in the war graves area of Carlisle Cemetery. Maintained by The Commonwealth War Graves Commission. In good condition.

CARLISLE CEMETERY NEW WAR MEMORIAL RICHARDSON STREET



The memorial is a small sandstone structure supporting an inscribed plaque. It is located at the junction of two roads in the cemetery and is set on a tiered sandstone flag base. Maintained by Carlisle City Council. In good condition, refurbished in June 2014.

STANWIX CEMETERY WAR MEMORIAL SCOTLAND ROAD



The monument is a square section granite obelisk with carved draped urn on top set in a circular flower bed with grass surround in the centre of the cemetery. Two sides of the memorial are inscribed with names. Maintained by Carlisle City Council. In good condition, professionally cleaned in May 2014.

UPPERBY CEMETERY WAR MEMORIAL MANOR ROAD





The memorial is a plaque bearing the city crest listing the names, service, regiment and former department of Carlisle Corporation employees who were killed in action in the second world war. There are 23 names on the memorial Maintained by Carlisle City Council. In good condition, refurbished in May 2014.
